What is 1Point3Academy?

Simply put! It is an online virtual platform a bit like the one room schoolhouse where children can work together based on ability rather than age, although our courses are listed in age order. Our lessons are in the style of a flipped classroom where we incorporate a mixture of recorded sessions with live sessions (Enterprise Plan).

1Point3Academy serves as a central hub for our learning community, where there is something for the whole family.

We stand with the principle that education is changing dramatically worldwide especially since the Covid19 pandemic which reminded parents of the freedoms that are possible to them. Our world is changing and it is changing very fast so education must adapt the way we teach and how we teach. So we at **1Point3Academy** are doing just that!

Rethinking what we teach?

We are not rethinking what we teach as such, but are returning to what we consider the best practises in education. We simplify it from the very beginning by going back to the basics in education (the foundation) for every child and we then build upon that.

The enterprise plan is for families that prefer someone else to teach certain subjects to their child. This plan blends together **IPoint3Curriculum** with other tried and tested curricular that we give a stamp of approval.

Admission

Admission to 1Point3Academy is not based upon one's intelligence or prior achievements. However, the specific class you choose to enroll in may have certain prerequisites or eligibility criteria. To proceed, please follow the steps outlined below.

- 1. Decide on which plan or course you are interested in.
- 2. Register your interest by filing out a quick form.
- 3. Attend an online consultation via zoom so that we can discuss how we can best help you.
- 4. Read our terms and conditions, code of conduct and statement of faith.
- 5. Make a final decision to join and commit to the term.
- 6. Pay a non refundable registration fee of £75.
- 7. Accept a place on your plan or course.
- 8. Attend a 'Parent Orientation Day'.
- 9. Student begin their assessments.
- 10. Student starts their appropriate learning programme.



Code of Conduct

Behaviour

We have a zero tolerance behaviour policy and children are expected to be well behaved during their online classes and during any physical meet ups. Parents are responsible for their children at all times but children are responsible for their own behaviours.

- Please arrive to class 5 minutes early.
- Please ensure that cameras are turned on during live classes.
- Please only use first names on your Zoom account.
- Please understand that we record all of our classes.
- Please note, we expect all children to interact in a way that is comfortable for them (messaging, hands up, type form or audibly).

Rewards and Sanctions

We use a gamification tool that rewards students with points. These points can be turned into gifts that will either be physical or digital and will be sent to your email or to your home address at the right time.

Differing Needs

We support children with a variety of learning needs and leaning styles. Please let us know during the interview stage if your child has additional needs so that we can create a tailored made plan in advance of lessons (if needed).

Auditorial learners

We provide audio lessons in our pre-recorded classes as some students learn best when they can see and hear what they are studying, rather than just reading it.

Kinaesthetic learners

We encourage hands on activities at home and provide spaces for children to share their work which encourages them to complete the tasks.

Social learners

Our live classes are perfect for social learners as they will have the chance to interact with others.

Visual learning

Animated lessons and video instructions are easier to understand for the visual learner which are fully enabled in our classes.

Ensuring the Best Start!

We ensure the best start by carrying out assessments at the start, during and at the end of each course / session. Regardless of age we expect all children's foundational knowledge to be secure before moving onto the next phase in their learning journey.


History and Geography Curriculum














Science and Bible Curriculum


In our bible curriculum, children simply read through and discuss the bible.
